

Capacity Enhancement Grant Report 2016-2017

The 2016-17 academic year has covered several developments that were supported by the Capacity Enhancement Grant.

Continuing with previous years' development, the college-wide WiFi network has been modified and upgraded with additional wireless access points and more powerful network switches to meet the growing demands on the use of a variety of eLearning platforms, including (but not limited to) Denbigh, Haiku and ManageBac. Annual subscription renewal fees of such platforms were also covered as recurrent costs. For the same purpose, additional laptops were acquired either as replacement (after a 5-year depreciation cycle) for existing staff or computing device for new staff.

Because of the huge demands of the IB 5 Year Review, the newly established IT Developments Committee was put on hold until the following school year to review the existing platforms and IT facilities, investigate alternatives in the market and put together proposals for further developments to the entire college community.
